



## Mr. Walter W. Brickley

Walter William Brickley 1922 - 2012 LENOX Walter W. Brickley, most recently of Devonshire Estates in Lenox, and a longtime resident of Marlboro Drive in Pittsfield, passed away July 7, 2012, at the Berkshire Medical Center. Walter was the loving husband of Edith Lillian Brickley for 67 years. Walter was born Jan. 6, 1922, in Providence, R.I. He enlisted in the Navy in October 1942 and his first assignment was in Naval Intelligence at the Charlestown Navy Yard in Boston. He also served on the World War II Destroyer, the USS Norman Scott, which traveled through the Panama Canal to the Pacific and saw service at Pearl Harbor and the Marshall and Mariana Islands. He was wounded during the Battle of Tinian and was awarded a purple heart. Walter and Lillian were married on April 1, 1945, on Mare Island in California. They moved east after both were honorably discharged from the Navy on Aug. 15, 1945, for Walt to attend Bentley College in Waltham. Upon graduation, he began a long and illustrious career at General Electric in Schenectady, N.Y., Bridgeport, Ct. and Pittsfield. Walter loved to ice skate and play ball and he excelled at golf, skiing and tennis, activities he learned as an adult. Walt was active in community affairs and was a longtime member of the Berkshire Hills Country Club. He and Lil spent many happy winters in their Sarasota, Florida home upon his retirement. Walter is survived by his wife, Lillian; his son, Michael Brickley and his wife Cathy; daughter Janice Brickley and daughter Carol Robertson and her husband Tom. He is also survived by his sister, Barbara Dello Russo of Medford and her husband, Rich. He was dearly loved

by his children, his grandchildren (Christina Stanton, Zachary Ethier, Ashley Keedy and Brian Messier, Jeff Keedy, Matt and Jen Brickley, and Lisa Brickley) and three great grandchildren.
