Mr. Wayne G. "Butch" Brunell, of Pittsfield, passed away at his home on Friday, March 24, 2023, with his loving family by his side. Born in Adams, MA, on June 9, 1944, he was the son of the late Gilbert and Irene Bechard Brunell. He graduated in 1962 from the former Adams High School and later earned his Associate Degree in Finance at Hudson Valley Community College. Butch was also a graduate of the General Electric Company's Financial Management Program.

Butch was employed by General Electric for 26 years, where he worked in finance and payroll. He later worked for Braza Bra Corp. as an accountant retiring in May 2008 with 15 years of service. He continued working at Braza Bra on a Part time basis until he fully retired in February 2022.
