Mr. William F. Loehr, 81, of 18 Baver Dr., formerly of Lenox Ave., passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, May 23, 2013 surrounded by his loving family. Born in Pittsfield on December 3, 1931 the son of Joseph F. and Katherine F. Gorman Loehr he grew up on the family farm in Washington MA until moving to Pittsfield at the age of 13 and was a 1950 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Loehr was a US Marine Corps veteran, serving in the Korean War. He entered the service in 1951 and was discharged in 1954 with the rank of Sergeant.

Bill raised his family on Lenox Ave. in Pittsfield where he lived for 44 years. He worked as a Milkman for forty one years, working at Crescent Creamery as a route supervisor for twenty seven years and then for H.P. Hood and Sons as a route coordinator for fourteen years. He retired in 1995. After retirement, he held several part time jobs, including working at Harry's Supermarket and The Dwyer Funeral Home.

Mr. Loehr was a fan of the Boston Red Sox. He loved to golf and enjoyed watching his children's and grandchildren's sporting events. He was a member of the VFW post 448.

He was a communicant of St. Charles Church for 54 years, where he volunteered for many church functions and also served as an usher.

Bill was predeceased by his first wife of 42 years, the former June R. Helliwell, whom he married on October 22, 1955 at St. Joseph's Church, she passed
