



Mr. William "Bill" Mara

November 4, 1935 - March 12, 2024

William "Bill" Mara, 88, of Pittsfield, passed away on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, after a short illness. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on November 4, 1935, son of the late Bernard Mara and Margaret Callahan Mara, he graduated from St. Joseph High School with the class of 1953.

For the majority of his career, William was employed by General Electric. He graduated from GE's apprentice program and moved on through other positions and completed his career as a computer analyst. It was from there he retired after 40 years of dedicated service.

Among many things, he enjoyed spending time with family and friends, golf, racquetball, and football officiating which was his passion for many years. He served as the Secretary-Treasurer of the Berkshire County Football Officials Association (BCFOA) and the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Football Officials (EAIFO).

William is survived by his beloved wife of 66 years, the former Elena Provenzano, whom he married on May 4, 1957. He leaves behind his son William Mara (Jean), daughters Nancy Ennis (Robert) and Susan Curran (David), and his six grandchildren, Jill Ennis, William Mara, Kaitlin Mara, Christopher Mara, Sara Ennis and Erin Curran.
